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ABOUT FUJIAN



Fujian, briefly named Min, is situated on China's southeast coast with Fuzhou as its provincial seat. Covering a land area of 124,000 km² and a sea area of 136,000 km², the province enjoys a subtropical oceanic monsoon climate with an annual average temperature of 19.8 degrees Celsius. It exercises jurisdiction over nine prefectural cities (Fuzhou, Xiamen, Zhangzhou, Quanzhou, Sanming, Putian, Nanping, Longyan, Ningde), and Pingtan Comprehensive Pilot Zone.

Fujian is a land of rich history, diverse cultures, and picturesque landscapes. It boasts a thriving economy, extensive global connections, and an excellent business environment. It is dedicated to high-quality development across all sectors, transforming itself into a new region with dynamic mechanisms, upgraded industries, a prosperous people and a beautiful environment.

STAY AND RESIDENCE

Accommodation Registration

1. If you are staying in a hotel, please register at the hotel reception with a valid passport or other international travel documents.
2. If you are staying in other residences, please register at the local police station within 24 hours of arrival with a valid passport or other international travel documents, as well as your lease agreement or property ownership certificate.

Visa and Residence Permit

1. Please observe visa validity.

If you need to extend the duration of stay specified on your visa, please apply to the local exit-entry administration at least 7 days before it expires.

2. Please observe the residence permit validity.

If you plan to work and live in China after entering the country with a visa, please apply to the local exit-entry administration for a residence permit within 30 days of your

entry. To extend your stay in China beyond the validity period of your residence permit, please apply for an extension at least 30 days before it expires.

If you have changed passport or had other items on the residence permit changed, please apply to the local exit-entry administration for an information update within 10 days of the change.



Loss of Passport

In case you lose your passport, please apply for a *Confirmation of Reporting the Loss of Passport* at the local exit-entry administration at the prefectural city level for passport replacement.

PAYMENT SERVICES

Bank cards issued in your home country/region can be accepted if the logos of your bank cards, such as Visa and Mastercard, are displayed at the checkout counter. If you hold a UnionPay card, it can be accepted by all merchant POS terminals in China's mainland.

You can enjoy convenient payment services with just a mobile phone. Mobile payment services are available through apps like Alipay, WeChat Pay and UnionPay.

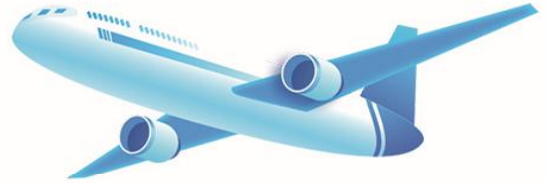


You can withdraw RMB cash by your bank card at an ATM with corresponding international payment network logos. You can also directly exchange at bank outlets with currency exchange signs, money changers or self-service kiosks.

TRANSPORTATION



Air

There are three major international airports in Fujian: Fuzhou Changle International Airport, Xiamen Gaoqi International Airport and Quanzhou Jinjiang International Airport.

Fuzhou Changle International Airport, located in Changle District, about 39 km from downtown Fuzhou, is an ICAO code 4E airport. It serves as a regional hub and a major gateway to cities and regions along the Maritime Silk Road. For more information, please visit <http://www.fuzhouairport.com.cn>.

Xiamen Gaoqi International Airport is situated in northeastern Xiamen Island, serving as a vital regional aviation hub in East China. It is an ICAO code 4E airport with two terminals: T3 and T4. For more information, please visit <https://www.xiamenairport.com.cn>.

Quanzhou Jinjiang International Airport is located in Jinjiang City, approximately 12 km from downtown Quanzhou. It is an ICAO code 4D airport. For more information, please visit <https://www.qzair.com/#/>.

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Train

Fujian is well connected by rail, offering swift and convenient travel options. To plan your journey, you can consult schedules and book tickets via the website of China Railway or the Railway 12306 app. The website of China Railway: <https://www.12306.cn/en/index.html>.

Ticket Purchase

China's railway operator implements real-name ticketing. You must complete identity verification before purchasing tickets.

1. You can log in to the 12306 website or app to fill in your name, nationality, ID number and other information following the instructions. The system will automatically complete identity verification. Or, you can upload a photo of the passport information page for manual verification.
2. You can also take valid identification documents to the ticket office at the railway station for identity verification.

Railway Station Entry/Exit and Train Boarding

With tickets and the original valid identification documents used when buying the tickets, you can enter and exit the

railway station through automatic or manual fare gates. Ticket verification may be required on the train.

All cities in Fujian offer bus services. Fuzhou and Xiamen have metro lines. You can buy single-journey tickets with cash. You can also use local bus or metro cards, which can be applied for at the local government service window or through the Alipay app.

To use the Alipay app, open it on your phone, tap “Transport”, and select “City”. After completing identity verification, you will obtain a QR code for public travel. Have the QR code scanned when you get on the bus or enter the metro station.

Taxi



You can hail a taxi on the street or use Alipay, WeChat or the DiDi app to book ride-hailing services. Here are the detailed

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instructions:

1. Open the Alipay app, tap "Transport", select "Taxi", and enter the pick-up and drop-off locations.
2. Open the WeChat app, tap "Me", select "Pay and Services", scroll down and tap "Travel Service" or "DiDi Ride-Hailing", and enter the pick-up and drop-off locations.
3. Download the DiDi app, which supports registration using foreign mobile phone numbers and international credit cards. Once registered, enter the pick-up and drop-off locations and choose from available service options (Express, Taxi, Premier or 6-Seater).

Car

You can convert your foreign driver's license into a Chinese one after passing China's driving and physical exams.

EMPLOYMENT

According to Chinese law, foreigners working within China shall first obtain a work permit.



For stays up to 90 days:

- Apply for a Z visa from a Chinese embassy or consulate with the *Notification Letter of Foreigner's Work Permit*.



- Work in China within the visa's validity period.

For stays exceeding 90 days:

- Apply for a Z visa from a Chinese embassy or consulate with the *Notification Letter for Foreigner's Work Permit*.
- Within 30 days of entry, apply for a *Foreigner's Work Permit* from the administration department of foreigners working in China where your employer is located.
- Work within the validity period of the permit.

To extend your *Foreigner's Work Permit*, you shall submit an extension application to the department of human resources and social security where your employer is located at least 30 days before your permit expires.

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In case of any change in personal information (name, passport number, or position), you shall submit an application for change to the administration department of foreigners working in China where your employer is located within 10 working days of the change.

SOCIAL INSURANCE

Foreigners who work in China shall access social security in accordance with Chinese law. However, nationals from countries such as Germany, Republic of Korea, Denmark, Canada, Finland, Switzerland, the Netherlands, France, Spain,

Japan, Serbia, and Luxembourg, which have concluded social security agreements with China, may be exempt from the obligation to pay insurance premiums for specified periods as stipulated in these agreements.

MEDICAL CARE

For common illnesses, you can visit the outpatient department of a nearby public medical institution at or above the secondary level. Outpatient services are generally available from morning to afternoon, Monday to Friday, and on Saturday mornings. Opening hours may vary by hospital.

The outpatient treatment process generally involves: registration, payment, consultation, settlement, medication collection, examination (test), report collection, follow-up

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consultation, medication

administration, and re-examination.



For your first visit, please bring your valid identification documents (Foreign Permanent Resident ID Card, passport, etc.) to the payment window to obtain a medical card. Most hospitals require appointments to be made 1-14 days in advance. Appointments can be scheduled through online platforms (such as the hospital's WeChat account or mini-program, or the “就医购药” section of the 闽政通 app), phone reservations, or on-site booking.

In case of acute illness, you can go to the emergency department of any hospital for treatment. If you are unable to go by yourself, you can call 120 emergency hotline (English service is available in most areas of the province) to request an ambulance.

In case of severe or major illnesses that require inpatient stays for further treatment or surgery, the outpatient physician will issue an admission notice upon confirming the need for inpatient care. The patient shall present this notice at the inpatient service counter or cashier to complete the admission procedures.



Medical consultations may involve professional terminology related to diseases and medications. If necessary, it is recommended to have a Chinese-speaking companion accompany you during your visit.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

As a foreign employee in Fujian, you are required to enroll in the basic medical insurance program for urban employees, with contributions made by both the employer and the employee. Once enrolled, you are legally entitled to medical insurance benefits.

If you leave China before reaching the statutory pension age, your medical insurance individual account shall be retained, and renewed on a cumulative basis when you return to work in China. Alternatively, the balance of your individual account can be refunded in a lump-sum upon written application for terminating the account.

If you reside in China with a Foreign Permanent Resident ID Card but are not employed, you may, subject to local requirements, participate in the basic medical insurance for urban and rural residents, and enjoy the same social insurance benefits as Chinese citizens.



EDUCATION

Kindergarten options for expat children of appropriate age:

- The kindergarten section of schools for children of foreign nationals;
- Accredited kindergartens that enroll international students (please consult the local municipal education bureau for the list of schools).

Primary school options for expat children of appropriate age:

- Schools for children of foreign nationals: apply directly to these schools;
- Nearby accredited schools: apply to the education bureau of corresponding county or district.

MAIN ATTRACTIONS

Fujian is home to five UNESCO World Heritage sites, including Mount Wuyi, Fujian *Tulou*, Taining Danxia Landform, Kulangsu: a Historic International Settlement, and Quanzhou: Emporium of the World in Song-Yuan China. It also has an array of 5A national tourist attractions, such as Fuzhou's Three Lanes and Seven Alleys Historic District.

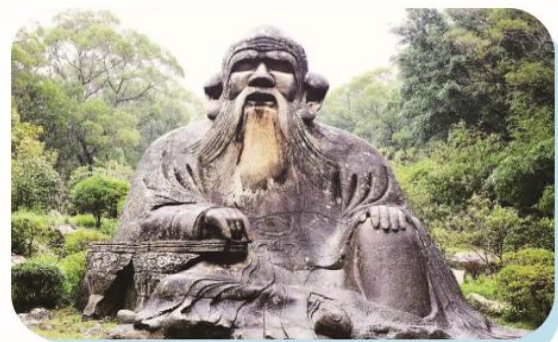

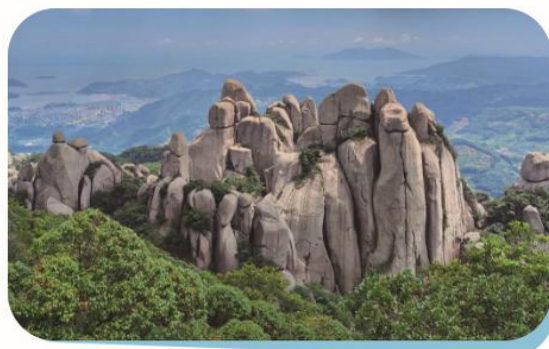
Mount Taimu Scenic Area, Fuding City, Ningde
